- Restructured front-end teams into fixed squads resulting in improved role clarity and enhanced collaboration, as confirmed by positive team feedback.

Added option to our CI github action to cancel concurrent jobs saving valuable running minutes. Improved GraphQL codegen setup. Currently building ESLint shareable configuration to automate conventions.
